

The project saw McGowan undertake preliminary access development works to allow for future NeSt structure installations on site.

The access terrain was extremely steep, as such the new road formation was bench cut in order to provide a suitable stable running surface, with further large rock armour material being utilised to further stable areas.

The access route was also prone to water ingress, thus proactive measures were implemented to control water run-off and prevent any potential silt pollution issues.

The project also saw the installation of crane pads and piling platforms along the route which entailed the importing of 20,000tons of rock infill.
