

The existing east foreshore approach accessway of the popular visitor attraction, Chanonry Point, Rosemarkie, had slowly been eroded over the last 10 years. As a result, the existing rock armour slope had collapsed, resulting in further damage and loss of sand and grass.

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Overview of works undertaken:

- 180m of two-tier gabion basket installation
- Placement of existing pebbles/stone from foreshore to protect new installed gabion baskets.
- Placement of existing, and imported rock armour to provide further protection to areas.
